On this tape recorded by Peter Wortsman, Kurt Schubert gives a lecture at the university of Vienna about antisemitism in Germany and Austria in the 19th century, focusing on specific antisemitic publications and political parties with antisemitic orientation.

Different ways of antisemitism

He mentions the two publications of *Juden, Juden* a book by Johann Andreas Eisenmenger and *Der Judenspiegel* by Hartwig Hundt; he gives an introduction on the beginnings of National Socialism and explains the role of religions and their interpretation; he quotes several laws related to the equality of Jewish people; and he describes antisemitism as a tool for political propaganda.

120 – 350

Antisemitic politicians, writers, and preachers and their theories

He mentions Adolf Stoecker: “Yes to the Jews, but no rights,” manipulation of the working class;
Wilhelm Marr: *Der Sieg des Judentums über das Germanentum*; establishment of the Anti-Semitic writers; Max Liebermann von Sonnenberg and the *Antisemitenpetition*, (The Antisemitic Petition); Theodor Fritsch Boeckel and the abuse of mediators between the city and the countryside; The *Antisemitentag* and the challenge to bring in antisemitic ideas to specific political parties.

The situation in Austria in the 19th century

Georg Heinrich Ritter von Schönerer and Karl von Vogelsang: their ideas, ideology, career, and influence in Austria;
The *Entenabende*, antisemitic evenings in the *Hotel zur Goldenen Ente*.
