Shvartsman, Feiha (Feiga) Naumovna, born in 1937 or 1938.

Her husband had relatives in Vapniarka. They came before the wedding. There was no money for the wedding. It was held with borrowed money in a shed. A few neighbors attended her wedding. There was a Jewish klezmer band of around six musicians. Those who wanted to dance had to pay the musicians.

Her husband was 11 years old when he lost his parents. His mother was shot near Gaisin (Haisyn). His father was killed at the front. He was left to care for his little sister.

She does not speak Yiddish, but understands when it is spoken.
