Karaim family Shabanov lived here. He was the head of the vegetable brigade in the village. He was a very good and serious worker. His wife was a teacher. They had two sons.

Before the war there was a Jewish kolkhoz (collective farm) here. Shabanov family lived in the village of Zhuravli; the Kapyls came here from Ukraine; Bekker lived in Saky and is still there.

There is a place here called "the Jewish hillock." Many Jews were shot there. They say Jews were buried there in a ravine.
