



Esther Gelbart Frank

- Born in Poland in 1927
- German planes bombed her town when she was 12 years old
- Survived several ghettos and concentration camps
- 80 members of her family died during the Holocaust, including parents and grandparents on both sides
- Her three siblings all survived
- Liberated by Russians on May 8, 1945
- Immigrated to the United States in 1949, at the age of 22
- Legacy includes two sons and four grandchildren
