Gita Engel Frankel

- Born in Kalisz, Poland, in 1925
- Survived Zdunska Wola and Lodz ghettos; Auschwitz; Stutthof and Praust labor camps, and the Praust Death March
- Father and younger brother murdered by Nazis
- Older brother died of starvation in the Lodz Ghetto
- Liberated by Russians in 1945
- Hospitalized for two and a half years following liberation
- Immigrated to the United States in 1957
- · Legacy includes two children and five grandchildren
