



Harold Koppel

- Born in Cologne, Germany, in 1927
- Restrictive laws prohibited doctors like Harold's father from treating non-Jews
- Witnessed Kristallnacht at the age of 11
- Sister went to England on the Kindertransport
- Father survived six harrowing weeks in Dachau
- Family escaped from Nazi Germany to England in 1939
- Family stayed in England for nine months before immigrating to the U.S.
- Legacy includes three children, seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren
