George Kronenberg

- Born in Warburg, Germany, in 1928
- Experienced Kristallnacht at the age of 10
- Family's apartment was robbed and vandalized on Kristallnacht; father was arrested and released the same day
 Left Germany with his twin sister on the Kindertransport in 1938
- Left Germany with his twin sister on the Kindertransport in 1938
 Smuggled grandfather's pocket watch, a family heirloom, out of Germany
- Sister was mistreated by her foster family in England
- Parents were sent to Theresienstadt and then to Auschwitz, where they were murdered in 1944
- Immigrated to the United States in 1946 with his sister to live with an aunt and uncle in Cleveland
