

Holocaust Survivor Hal Myers (Hans Siegfried Hanauer)



Hal Myers (Hans Siegfried Hanauer)

- Born in Karlsruhe, Germany, in 1930
- Witnessed Kristallnacht at the age of 8
- Sister was sent on Kindertransport
- Parents were murdered at Auschwitz; many other relatives died
 Supplied Gue Concentration Comp. in France.
- Survived Gurs Concentration Camp in France Rescued from Gurs by Quaker relief group along with his brother and sent to America in 1941
- Adopted by David and Inez Myers, together with his brother
- Legacy includes six children and 17 grandchildren


