- Born in Lodz, Poland, in 1929
- Ten years old when the war broke out
- Survived the Lodz Ghetto for five years
- Father died in the Lodz ghetto; mother and four siblings were mur-
- dered by the Nazis Survived Auschwitz and Bergen-Belsen and a labor camp near Hamburg
- Liberated from Bergen-Belsen in 1945
- Immigrated to Cleveland in 1947 with her one surviving sister;
- enrolled in Cleveland Heights High School Legacy includes five children, 16 grandchildren, and one greatgrandchild


