



### **Sarah Schneider Radzeli**

- Born in Czechoslovakia in 1929
- Survived Auschwitz-Birkenau
- Spent a year at forced labor in an ammunition factory in Czechoslovakia
- Liberated by Russians in 1945 and reunited with her brother in Budapest
- Tried to immigrate to Palestine in 1946 on an illegal ship
- Ship was stopped and she was sent to a Displaced Persons (DP) camp in Cyprus
- Lived in Israel for 12 years after it became a state
- Immigrated to the United States in 1960 with husband and son
- Only survivors from her immediate family were Sarah and her brother
