## Sarah Schneider Radzeli

- Born in Czechoslovakia in 1929
- Survived Auschwitz-Birkenau Spent a year at forced labor in an ammunition factory in
- Czechoslovakia Liberated by Russians in 1945 and reunited with her brother in Budapest
- Tried to immigrate to Palestine in 1946 on an illegal ship
- Ship was stopped and she was sent to a Displaced Persons (DP) camp in Cyprus
- Lived in Israel for 12 years after it became a state Immigrated to the United States in 1960 with husband and son
- Only survivors from her immediate family were Sarah and her brother
- Holocaust Survivor Sarah Schneider Radz


