



Leo Silberman

- Born in Poland in 1925, one of 7 children
- Survived 6 concentration camps, including Plaszow, Skarzysko, Buchenwald and Theresienstadt
- Jewish Brigade attempted to smuggle him and others to Palestine
- Caught by American soldiers in Italy and sent to DP camp in Germany
- One sister moved to Palestine in 1938 as a pioneer; remainder of his family was killed
- Immigrated to the United States in 1949
- Legacy includes three children and six grandchildren
