- He lives in a street, in which many Jews used to live

Non Jewish aspects:

- Recalls the retaliation measures of Nazis towards local population
- Good relation with the Italian occupation forces, but he remembers the confiscation of the live stock
- The period of Nazi occupation was a period of fear
