00.02.07 Hebrew Prayers.

00.04.21 Organizer of the commemoration ceremony is making a speech at the monument of the "old doctor." (The old doctor is Janusz Korczak). He asks the "older brothers", Israelites, to pray in unity with Christians, especially for children. The prayer is Psalm 94. He mentions the tragedy of a noble man and victims, especially children.

00.07.12 Prayer in Polish.

00.10.42 The organizer is talking about a prayer about thankfulness and unity with the Israelites and the work for children. "Let us hold hands together." "Our Father" prayer follows.

00.11.15 A man recites a poem by Władysław Szlengel, written in 1943 after Korczak's deportation. The poem describes children walking to their death and the children wearing clean clothes.

00.12.34 Hebrew prayer.

00.13.51 Song in a military style about citizens of Warsaw, something about kissing girls, not clear.

00.15.56 Song about military life, long road to victory, patriotic.

00.20.43 Song for a girlfriend, love for her.

00.22.25 Military song glorifying Poland's call to arms.

00.24.04 Song about victory, about children of Warsaw, about going to fight.
